Avsenik Brothers Ensemble



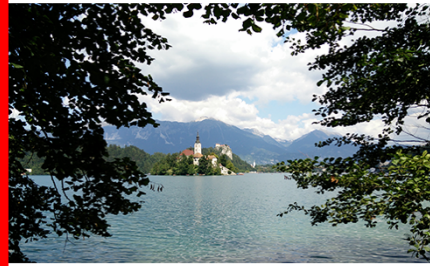
Slovene Oberkrainer music band

Lect Hearts



Honey bread with ornaments

In 19th century hearts were a cherished gift among lovers

Today hearts are mostly a beautiful tourist souvenir

Tolmin Gorges



The lowest and probably the most beautiful entry point into the Triglav National Park

In one hour trip visitors can see Dante's Cave, Devil's Bridge and a triangular rock called the Bear's Head

Crystal clear and very cold water

Zipline Učja



The biggest Zipline park in Europe

Ten steel cables from 100-150 meters above the river Učja

Breathtaking panoramic views

Goriška brda



The landscape is mostly surrounded by vineyards and orchards

The Cherry Festival is the biggest and most attention-grabbing cultural and tourist event in Slovenia

Vineyard Heroes Cycling Marathon from Ljubljana to Wine Cellar Goriška brda

Solkan Bridges



Two bridges over the emerald green queen, Soča river

Railroad bridge with the longest stone arch in the world

Road bridge offers bungee jumping with a great view

Dragon Bridge



Appears in the most recognizable images of Ljubljana

The four dragon statues, which look slightly terrifying and almost real

The bridge is a unique creation and Ljubljana's first reinforced concrete structure

Idrija Town



Famous bobbin lace - Idrija Lace

The oldest mining hub in the country

Idrija žlikrofi - a type of pasta filled with potato

Port of Koper



The only Slovenian international freight port

The closest connection of Central and Eastern Europe to the Mediterranean

Number of terminals, eg. container and car terminal and also a cruise terminal

Sečovelje Saltworks



The largest Slovenian salt evaporation pond

Salt is still produced in a traditional way

The Museum of Salt making

C2

Lipizzaner



A breed of horse originating in Lipica

The Lipica stud farm is the world's oldest continuously operating stud farm

Lipizzaners measure between 147-157 cm and live and are active longer than many other breeds

Postojna Cave



24km long karst cave system

Queen of the Underground World

The world's first railway in an underground cave

Babno polje fields



The coldest inhabited settlement in Slovenia with official lowest temperature of -34.5 °C

The original village was burnt by the Turks in 1528

Legend: place Crone of babno got its name after a crone, the only survivor of Turkish attacks, who saved by hiding in a heap of manure

Triple Bridge



A group of three bridges across the Ljubljanica River

Connect medieval and modern city of Ljubljana

Opened for traffic in 1932, from renovation in 2007 a pedestrian zone

D1

Kolpa River



113 km (of 292 km) of the river run along the country border with Croatia

Considered the longest Slovenian "coastline"

Offers boating, canoeing, kayaking, rafting etc.

D1

Terme



Rehabilitation centre, developed after the World War II

One of the oldest health resorts in Europe

Water temperature of the human body - most suitable for the health

D2

Brown Bear



Weights between 100-150 kg

Plant food amounts represents 70-85% of his diet, while meat just 15-30%

A great traveller, good runner (tens of km per day), fast swimmer

Woodenware craft



Close connection of the inhabitants with nature and the richness of forests

Simple products originally for domestic use

The issued patent for free trading offered the poorer an additional source of income

Grosuplje Town



Important road and railway junction

Exhibited statues of established sculptors

Home of a large number of famous Slovenian people

D3

Žale cemetery



One of the most beautiful cemeteries in Europe

Most famous Slovenians are buried at Žale

Cultural heritage tours at the cemetery

Laško Brewery



The largest brewery in Slovenia

Guided tour of the brewery includes a museum pass and tasting in local bars

Annual summertime

Fairy tale and fantasy land

Relaxing walk in the forest

Collection of souvenirs

Hayracks



Elaborately made of wood

Intended for the drying
of hay, straw and maize

Slovenia's foremost museum of historical art

Holds the country's largest collection
of fine art from the High Middle Ages

The oldest monastery in Slovenia

Important religious, cultural
and economic centre

Traditional meeting of Catholic youth

Jeruzalem



An idyllic village built around the church

A wine road with an unforgettable view

Vinarium Tower



The highest observation tower in Slovenia

It allows views into four different countries: Slovenia, Hungary, Austria and Croatia

It offers a beautiful 360° view of the beautiful scenery

Kurent Festival



One of Slovenia's most popular and ethnologically significant carnival events

Its main figure, Kurent, wears traditional sheepskin garments and holds wooden clubs with hedgehog skins attached

Event is believed to "chase away winter"

Safe driving centre



Asphalted surface with well-maintained training tracks

For simulating different types of driving conditions

Primarily designed as a facility to provide training under safe conditions

Ljubljana Castle



Castle is standing on a hill above the city

Also serves as a venue for cultural and other events

Offer some of the most beautiful views of the city Ljubljana

Trojane Doughnut



An apricot jam-filled doughnut

This dessert is especially interesting during the Carnival time

They have round shape (not the ring shape as it is usual for doughnuts)

Prekmurska gibanica



A dessert, considered a Slovene national culinary specialty

Consists of two types of pastry and four different fillings

Special process of preparing and baking

White stork



A sign of luck and honour

Build their nests on church steeples, rooftops or telephone poles

Live on a diet of worms, grasshoppers, frogs and small rodents

Football



A professional football club from Maribor

Have won a record number of titles in Slovenia

Have a loyal and passionate fan base and has the highest attendance in Slovenia

Snow castle



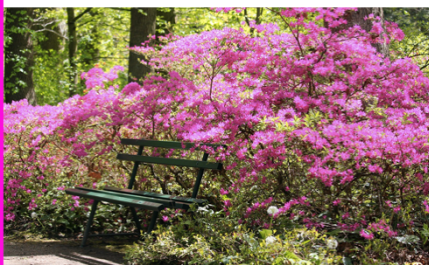
The winter event
